August 30, 2022 Board Meeting

District Office

Present: Frank DeTrolio, Marilyn Meseberg, Chad Nordberg, Ann Belchik-Moser, Carina LeFave, Ryan Kuhn, and Cheyenne Griffith.

Meeting called to order at 12:11 PM

Motion to accept minutes of July 26, 2022 made by Chad Nordberg. Seconded by Frank DeTrolio. Motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

A. Project Update

Ann provided an update with the project. Coffman Civil Engineering is almost done with the sewer pump design and the cost estimate should be done soon.

B. Vehicle Purchase Update

Since the state contract does not have vehicles available for purchase, the National Fleet Group is approved to order vehicles for purchase. Back in February 2022, the board approved the purchasing of two vehicles up to \$100,000.00. Now, Ford has vehicles that can be ordered, but two F150 Super Crew trucks with delivery and tax will cost \$109,140.72.

Motion to approve the purchase of two new trucks in the amount of \$109,140.72 made by Frank DeTrolio. Seconded by Chad Nordberg. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

C. FCS Group – 2023 Assessment Roll

Ann reached out to FCS Group for the 2023 assessment roll. The last two years the fee was the same, but this year they had to increase their prices.

Motion to pay FCS Group \$15,835.00 to provide the 2023 Assessment Roll made by Chad Nordberg. Seconded by Frank DeTrolio. Motion passed unanimously.

D. Preliminary Budget

In the preliminary budget Ann budgeted an additional \$150,000.00 for insecticides to prep for the Supplemental Feed Routes extra water and increased breeding habitat. The district is also using more organic adulticide and projected to continue to use more in the coming years. It is also time to trade in district ATV's and purchase new ones with the intention to purchase an additional ATV to improve surveillance efficiency.

E. Operations Update

Ann provided an operations update. The weather is slowly shifting with the cooler mornings, but the district still plans to continue to applicate into October. This season the lab has set 1,138 adult mosquito traps and tested 351 mosquito samples. The district has not detected West Nile virus yet this season.
